Britannia Village Flood Control Project

NOTICE of FILING DOCUMENT for REVIEW

The Rideau Valley Conservation Authority (RVCA) has now completed a Project Plan regarding a proposed remedial flood control project for the Britannia Village community located in Lot 20, Concession 1 (Ottawa River Front) of the former Township of Nepean, now in the City of Ottawa.

The Project Plan has been prepared in accordance with the Class Environmental Assessment for Remedial Flood and Erosion Control Projects, approved for projects of this type.

As described in the Project Plan, the RVCA, in cooperation with the City of Ottawa, is proposing to construct and maintain an improved system of flood control measures consisting of earthen dykes, reinforced concrete flood walls, and rip-rap or armour-stone shoreline erosion protection measures. These measures will reduce the potential for flood damages and flood-related public safety risks in the community, by preventing the overland passage of flood waters into the community during 1:100 year, and more frequently occurring, flood conditions on the Ottawa River.
