



The Rideau Valley Conservation Authority (RVCA), in cooperation with the City of Ottawa, has commenced a planning and design process for the Britannia Village Flood Control Project.

Notice of Intent Britannia Village Flood Control Project

This project will protect parts of the Britannia Village community that would otherwise be affected by overbank flooding during future Ottawa River floods.

Its purpose is to reduce expected property damages, public safety risks and inconvenience in this existing community during future flood events, up to and including the 1:100 year flood.

The RVCA invites you to participate in the planning and design process, which is to be carried out according to the Conservation Ontario Class Environmental Assessment for Remedial Flood and Erosion Control Projects, approved for this type of undertaking. Your input will be incorporated into the planning and design process for this project.

A Community Liaison Committee will also be formed to assist the RVCA through the design and construction process.
